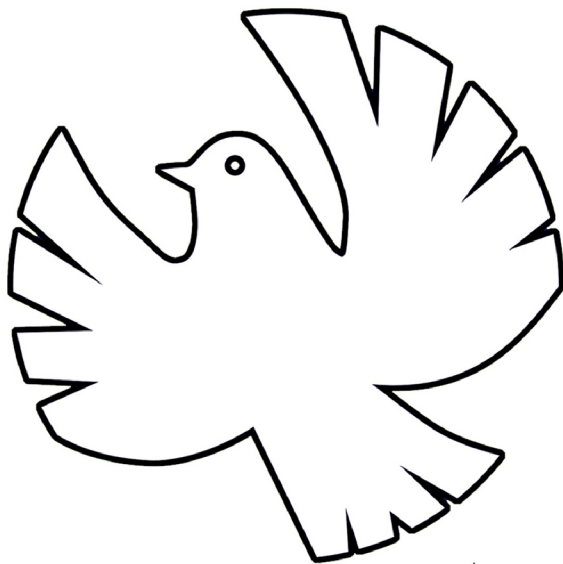

The Father loves the world


The Holy Spirit as Tongues of fire


The gifts of The Holy Spirit given for service






Walk by the Spirit


Acts of the flesh






Hope does not put us to shame




